Dear Valued Exhibitor,

Karen and I would like to thank you for attending the Las Vegas Antique Firearms, Sporting Arms and Custom Knifemakers shows, at the Westgate Las Vegas Resort & Casino. This will be the fifty-eight year for the Antique Arms Show and Beinfeld Productions strives to create a safe and memorable experience for everyone.

Our security procedures have not change from last year, but I would like to take this opportunity to review them with you.

All firearms are to remain unloaded at all times. No firearms will be allowed within the resort and casino. All firearms will be confined to the Convention Center. If you are a guest at the Westgate, you will not be able to store your firearms in your room.

All exhibitors are to load-in and out at the convention parking lots located by their show room. After you have unloaded your vehicle, promptly move your vehicle to the parking structure or the north parking lot. The Westgate will be providing a shuttle service continuously throughout our show to transport you back to the convention center.

If you park in valet, you must have a bellman transport your firearms to the convention center. You must accompany the bellman while they transport your firearms. At the conclusion of the show, you will again need a bellman to take your firearms back to valet.

Wednesday February 26<sup>th</sup>, we utilize the show rooms as the security rooms. The opening time will be about 4 pm. You may drop off your merchandise until 8 am Thursday. Place your belongings on or under your table(s) or in your booth, and exit the room in a timely manner. Do not leave your vehicle parked in the lot behind the antique show room. There are 450 exhibitors to move-in and space is limited.

If you will be arriving after 6 pm on Thursday, you may bring your firearms into the show room. Please call me so I may alert the security personnel. If you unload your vehicle at the hotel main entrance, you must use a bellman to transport your firearms to the show rooms.

If you will be arriving prior to Wednesday February 26<sup>th</sup>, please call me at 951-970-9669 to make arrangements for storage of your firearms.

We will also provide a storage area at the close of the show on Sunday. It will be located in the antique show room, located in the northwest corner (by the roll-up door). This area will open up about 4 pm as people move out.

All cartridge firearms must be tied with a plastic tie to be rendered inoperable. Please arrive with your firearms tied or be sure to bring ties with you.
